

She trains to develop skills in policy-making

Farmington resident Carol Ann Kirkland, director of student activities at Henry Ford Community College, is one of 160 women in college administration chosen nationwide to participate in a leadership program financed by a grant from the Fund for Improvement of Postsecondary Education (FIPSE).

The program, "Leaders for the '80s," is being sponsored by the League for Innovation in Community Colleges and the American Association of Women in Community and Junior Colleges. Conducted by the Institute for Leadership Development at Rio Salado Community College in Arizona, the program is designed to help community college women assume major policy-making positions during the decade.

During the six-month program, participants will be paired with mentors at their colleges to work on a research project that will aid their institution and attend special regional and national conferences.

Kirkland's project, "A Peer Tutoring Project for HFCC Students," will be implemented at the college in September. Her mentor is Dr. Margaret Crisbal, HFCC's registrar.

AS PART of the program, Kirkland will take part in a "Leaders for the '80s" regional conference in Chicago, March 2-8.

Kirkland has been director of student activities at HFCC since February 1983. Before coming to HFCC, she held various positions at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor and Dearborn.

The director has a master's degree in educational psychology and guidance and counseling from U-M and a bachelor's degree in fine arts and a certificate in elementary education from U-M.

Kirkland is a member of the American College Unions-International, the Michigan Association of Women Deans, Directors and Counselors and the Michigan Association of Community College Student Personnel Administrators.

Last fall, Kirkland was a guest speaker at a meeting of The Women's Exchange, a network for business and professional women. Her topic of discussion was "Winning the Duel in a Dual-Career Marriage."

Kirkland's husband, Robert, teaches at HFCC and U-M-D. The couple has two children, Joseph and Daniel.

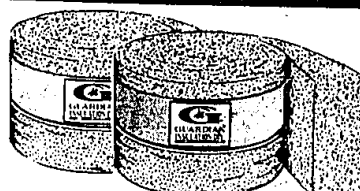
