**A CHILD'S RESPONSE TO DEATH**

Children's reactions to the death of a loved one can vary enormously. There is no single procedure and formula that will fit all youngsters either at the time of death or during the difficult period that follows. It depends, first of all, on the age and personality of the youngster. How mature is he? What is his basic physical and emotional health? What is his concept of death? How close was he to the deceased? Were the circumstances surrounding the death traumatic, or was the child well-prepared?

The variations are so great that it is difficult to judge what is normal from what is not. Psychologists generally advise talking to the child and encouraging him to express his feelings about the loss. However sometimes even these efforts are insufficient and professional help is needed.
