Taming the shrew:

Production brings out elements that would delight common folk

Director Jeff Nahan brings out the lusty, rollicking energy of "Taming of the Shrew" in the Actors Alliance Theatre Company's production of Shakespeare's comedy

Nahan puts "arew" squarely where Shakespeare intended it — as a play to please the rowdy common folk and not just the more thoughtful upper classes, "list direction of the fine Actors Alliance production bearly favors the robust preferences, of ordinary people over intellectuals and would have set the earthy tolk in the pits at the old Globe Theatre of Spakespeare's time to accompling their fet and roaring approval at the doubt entendre and the gymnastic energy of the cast.

Wayon David Parker is a light, hearted and lightfooted pleasure as Lucentio's other servant, the big lout, Blondello, well played by Charles A. Greenia, rounds out the characterizations.
