One game stands between the South Farmington Nationals Little League team and a trip to the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pa.

The Michigan state champions will face Highlands South, Ind., Saturday at 1 p.m. (noon Farmington time) in Kokomo, Ind. Farmington won the right to play the regional championship game with a win over Hyde Park, Ill., Thursday afternoon. (See Observer sports for details.)

Farmington's ace righthander, Dave Duelo, pitched in the Michigan team's 5-4 win over the Little Leaguers from Illinois. Because of a tournament rule prohibiting players from pitching two consecutive games, Jay Cummings will be on the mound in the championship game.

Highlands South, a suburb of Hammond, Ind., advanced to Saturday's finals with a 2-1 victory over the Iowa state champs, Fort Des Moines.

The winner of the South Farmington-Highland battle will be flown directly to Williamsport from Kokomo.

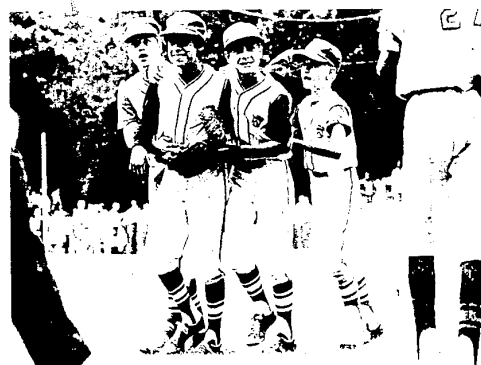

Scrap Grows

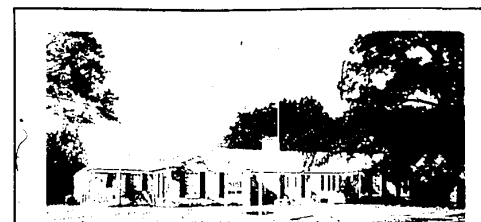
Americans are piling up solid scrap at a rate of 3 1/2 billion tons a year - 100 pounds a day for every man, woman and child.
