COM-ON-WONNA CAMP — Our day camp is designed for children 6-12 years of age and provides both educational and recreational programs. Campers will be involved in animal and insect study, fishing, archery, field trips and more. The camp is located at Oakland Community College, Orchard Ridge Campus. Camp runs five days a week and the first session begins June 24. Registration fee is \$32.

YOUTH SWIMMING — Registration is being accepted at the Parks & Recreation Office for youth swim lessons. Instructions for beginner and advance skill levels will be offered at Farmington and North Farmington High Schools, Monday through Thursday, beginning June 24. Sessions are two weeks in length. Children must be 38 inches at their chin height in order to participate. A pre-registration fee of \$18 is required.

PICNIC PACS — Need some games for your family reunion or picnic? The Parks & Recreation Division has a picnic pac for that special day. The package includes a volleyball, badminton set, horseshoes, softball and bat, frisbees and more. To reserve your picnic pac, call the Parks & Recreation office, seven days in advance of your outing. A \$20 deposit is required at the time of pick-up with a fee of \$8 for the weekend and \$5 fee per day during the week.

RECREATION SWIM TEAM — Farmington area youth, ages 7-17, will have the opportunity to swim on the Surf Skimmers Swim Team for the summer season. The swim team is for instructional purpose, although we do swim dual meets against other city teams and conclude with a final championship meet in August. A brief informational meeting will be held for all interested youth and parents at 7 p.m. Wednesday, June 12 at North Farmington High School. A \$24 registration fee is now being accepted at the Parks & Recreation office.

TENNIS LESSONS — Learn the basic fundamentals of the game or improve your existing skills through structured lessons at Farmington or North Farmington High Schools. Classes are 50 minutes in length, twice a week for four weeks and will begin June 17 for children, teens and adults. Each participant will provide tennis racket, shoes and a can of new tennis balls for the lessons. A \$20 registration fee should be made at the Parks & Recreation office.

JUNIOR GOLF LESSON PROGRAM — The Junior Golf program is

designed for all youth golfers, ages 9-17, who are interested in obtaining a comprehensive understanding of the game of golf. A five-session seminar will cover golf etiquette, proper fundamentals and basic golf strokes. Upon completion of the program, individuals will be eligible for the junior discount golf rate, golf tournament, leagues and other various items. A pre-registration fee of \$6 must be made at the Parks & Recreation office prior to June 14. The program will be held from 9 a.m. to 9:50 a.m. June 17, 19, 21, 24 and 26 at San Marino Golf Course.

FITNASTICS — Enjoy toning your body to a formulated routine of exercise and dance. The twice-a-week sessions will meet 6:30-7:30 p.m. Monday and Wednesday at the Farmington Club, 38500 Nine Mile. The fee for the six-week session is \$25 and you may pre-register at the Parks & Recreation office.

Cops nab man

Thomas Gerald Harriman was arraigned May 21 before 47th District Court Judge Michael Hand on two counts of attempted breaking and entering of a dwelling. Bond was set at \$10,000.

Harriman, an 18-year-old Farmington Hills resident, was arrested May 20 by Farmington Hills police.

Police had received information that a man had been committing breaking and entering, said Farmington Hills Police Chief William Dwyer.

The man and his residence were placed under surveillance by the S.P.O.T. (Special Patrol Operations Team) unit, under the supervision of Sgt. Marty Bledsoe.

"As a result of about a week's surveillance, the suspect was arrested (that) Monday at about 11:30 p.m.," Dwyer said.

The man was observed attempting to break into a home in Southfield, he said.

"He was arrested by our officers while he was under surveillance. They had observed him go to this particular home and attempt to break in." Earlier that evening, the man had been observed attempting to break into two homes in Farmington Hills, Dwyer said.

The arrest was made in the vicinity of Nine Mile and Inkster roads, he said.
