Chaldeans honoring high school grads

More than 190 Chaldean seniors from 20 Detroit area high schools have been invited to a special graduation ceremony in Southfield this weekend.

The event, sponsored by the Chaldean Federation of America, begins at 5 p.m. Saturday at Mother of God Church.

The ceremony, now in its third year, evolved from a program initiated by the Southfield-Lathrup Chaldean Youth Club, an organization begun by Kamal Eshaki, a teacher at Southfield-Lathrup High School.

This year's ceremony is expected to attract some 650 parents, friends, school officials and church members, Eshaki said.

The program will begin with a Mass

by His Excellency the Bishop Ibrahim Ibrahim. Keynote speaker will be James Bannon, deputy chief of the Detroit Police Department.

Other guest speakers will include Rami George, chairman of the federation, and Eshaki.

During the ceremony, one \$1,000 scholarship, two \$500 scholarships and 10 plaques will be awarded to students. All students attending the ceremony will be awarded certificates of achievement from the federation.

Following the ceremony, there will be a reception and refreshments at the church.

That evening, the Southfield-Lathrup Chaldean Youth Club will host a party for the graduates.
