
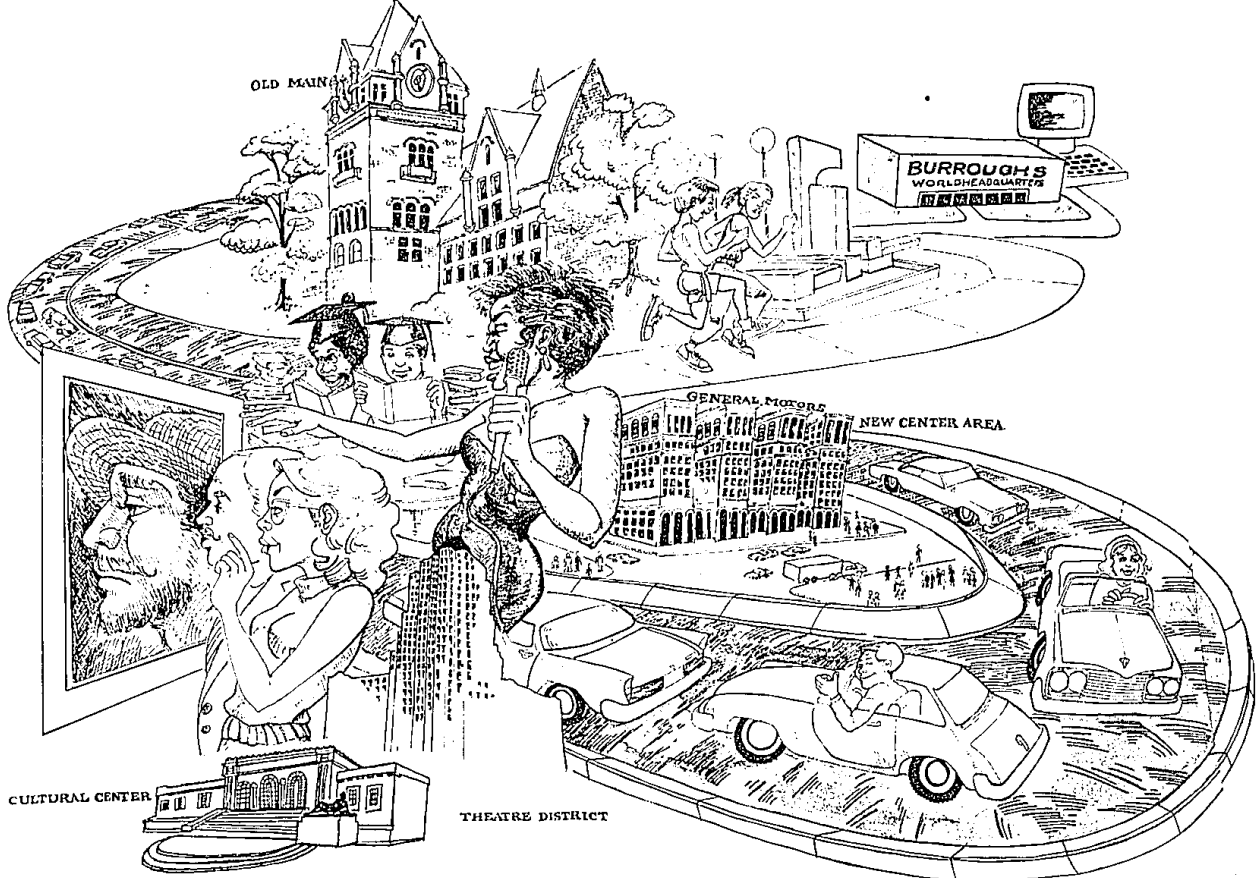

What's Unique About Wayne State University's Location?



It's the Heart of the Cultural Center . . .
It's the Hub of the Freeways . . .
It's a Short Drive from Your Home!

Almost all residents of Macomb, Oakland and Wayne counties are within 30 minutes of Wayne State University's main and medical campuses . . . and residents of the six-county metropolitan region are within an hour's drive away.

All roads lead to Wayne State University: I-94 (the Ford) from east or west; U.S. 10 (the Lodge) from north and northwest; I-75 (the Fisher) from downtown and I-75 (the Chrysler) from north and northeast; and I-96 (the Jeffries) from west and northwest. Several major surface streets also offer easy access.

Once you arrive, you've really arrived. You are in a major center of vitality and activity around Wayne State University: the Detroit Cultural Center. And a few blocks away is the New Center area; a mile away is the Detroit Medical Center, one of the finest and most comprehensive networks of health care institutions in the nation. And we are three miles from Downtown Detroit, Hart Plaza and the riverfront.

The Cultural Center is one of Detroit's best kept secrets. Discover beauty in the Detroit Institute of Arts. Mysteries of nature in the Detroit Science Center. Nostalgia for bygone days in the Detroit Historical Museum. The cross-cultural experience of the International Institute. And the joys of learning at Wayne State University.

The bustling world headquarters of General Motors and Burroughs are a few blocks north in the New Center. The Fisher Theatre and the Golden Tower of the Fisher Building. Shopping arcades. Fine restaurants. Sidewalk musical performances.

In the Medical Center, physicians and researchers from Wayne State University, Harper, Hutzel and Children's hospitals, the Rehabilitation Institute and Detroit Receiving Hospital work to cure illness and improve health care for all.

WSU is where the action is — the Three-Center area of Detroit, composed of the Cultural Center, the Medical Center and the New Center.
