"The money is adequate for this year," Deadman said.

"These programs usually take awhile for people to qualify for and become informed about."

City council will reassess the funds each year and modify eligibility criteria and procedures as needed, Deadman said.

Residents eligible for the minor home repair program must fall within the following income brackets:

- Household size of 1; maximum low income of \$11,400; maximum moderate income of \$18,200.
- Household size of 2; maximum low income of \$13,000; maximum moderate income of \$20,800.
- Household size of 3; maximum low income of \$14,600; maximum moderate income of \$23,400.
- Household size of 4; maximum low income of \$16,250; maximum moderate income of \$26,000.
- Household size of 5; maximum low income of \$17,550; maximum moderate income of \$27,650.

The city has participated in the CDBG program for the past decade and has always had a major home repair program until this year, Deadman said.

Under the major home repair program, low to moderate income families and senior citizens can receive low-interest home improvement loans.

Now the county is in charge of the major home repair program and tends

to replace rather than repair, Deadman said.

Applications for the major home repair program can be picked up by eligible residents at Farmington City Hall, according to Deadman.

Applications for the new minor home repair program may be obtained at Farmington City Hall or the senior citizens activity center located at 11 Mile and Middlebelt Roads in Farmington Hills.

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
