Oakland incinerator plan leaps committee hurdles

Two committees of the Oakland ounty Board of Commissioners Tuesty approved an intergovernmental greement to pay for trash disposal for is separate communities.

The action was considered an important first step toward implementing a countywide solid waste management plan using incinerators and landfills. "IT'S A framework, and the details will be worked out among the local communities, the county board and the executive," said county bond comselor Terry Donnelly.
"It sets up a Municipal Solid Waste Board with members from each community and the county board of commissioners to make decisions to manage and implement this system."
