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Phone customers must make long distance choice

Michigan Bell customers in the Farmington area again will be asked to select the long-distance company of their choice for "Dial 1 Plus" service, and if they make no selection, they'll be assigned to one of the companies providing service in their area.

"A few months ago, Farmington-area customers were asked to select a long-distance company, and if they

made no choice they would remain with AT&T," said Len Singer, local corporate affairs manager for Michigan Bell.

"Under a Federal Communications Commission decision, Michigan Bell now must randomly assign those customers who make no choice."

Singer said customers in the 471, 473, 474, 476, 477 and 478 exchanges soon

will receive information in the mail explaining the changes and another response card on which to make a selection.

To choose a long-distance company, customers need only check the appropriate box on the card they receive and mail it back to Michigan Bell in the self-addressed, postage-paid envelope provided.

"Dial 1 Plus" — which becomes available in the Farmington area in

August — enables customers to use any long-distance company offering the service in their area by dialing 1 plus the area code (where necessary) plus the telephone number. In the past, placing a call through any long-distance company other than AT&T required dialing as many as 22 digits.

"Dial 1 Plus" service will be available to Farmington Hills customers in the 553 and 661 exchanges in December.
