AMUSEMENT PARK DISCOUNT

TICKETS — In cooperation with the Michigan Recreation and Park Association, the Recreation Division is offering a variety of "fun tickets" at a savings to you. Tickets are on sale at the Recreation Office and the City of Farmington's Finance Department. Tickets include: African Lion Safari, AutoWorld, Bob-Lo Island, Canada's Wonderland, Cedar Point, Crossroads

Village, Detroit Zoo, Geauga Lake, Great American King's Island, Mackinac Island State Park, Michigan State Fair and Sea World.

VOLUNTEER SOCCER COACHES — The Parks and Recreation Division is seeking volunteer coaches to assist in our fall soccer program. Experience is

not necessary, just enjoy working with children. If you are able to commit one hour for one day during the week and on Saturday morning, contact Stu Rose at 474-6115, Ext. 288.

HUNTER'S SAFETY CLINIC — In accordance with Michigan State law, participation in a certified hunter's

safety clinic is required of all youth 12-16 years of age wishing to purchase their first hunting license. This six hour course is designed to teach all aspects of hunter's safety, and after successful completion of the course, a hunter's certificate will be issued. Clinic dates are 6-9 p.m. Tuesdays, Sept. 17 and 24, at the Farmington Hills Library. Pre-registration is required at the Parks and Recreation office.

KAYAK CLINIC — On Sept. 17 at the Farmington Hills Library at 7 p.m., individuals are invited to view a film that will show the basic strokes, equipment, safety, Eskimo roll and water experiences. Come and learn about this exciting activity. There is no charge for this clinic.

PUNT, PASS AND KICK — The Recreation Division will be sponsoring a punt, pass and kick competition for all children ages 8-13 of the Farmington area. The event will be held on Saturday, Sept. 28. Children ages 8-9 will compete at 9 a.m., ages 10 and 11 at 9:30 a.m., and ages 12 and 13 at 10 a.m. Awards will be presented to the first, second and third place finishers in each division with each winner advancing to the regional competition. There is no registration fee but pre-registration is required at the parks and recreation office.

FITNASTICS — Get in shape with our Fitnaastics instructor Norene. She will lead in cardiovascular exercises, stretching and toning movements. Basic exercise routines will allow you to progress at your own pace. Class is held on Monday and Wednesday, beginning 6:30-7:30 p.m. Monday, Sept. 16, for eight weeks. Class fee is \$35.

You must verify income to qualify for free food

According to the USDA rules, household income verification is required at least once a year, therefore, on Sept. 1, 1984, the Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency (OLHSA), the Community Action Agency which is responsible for the distribution of surplus commodity food in Oakland County, instituted a new pre-registration card system in order to help eliminate long lines, become more cost efficient and accurate, and to stop duplication in the program.

Surplus Commodity food registration card with their own registration number and the distribution site they must attend each time. The card also has their name, address, etc. This card must be presented to a clerk for verification every time they receive their commodities. Persons who have not yet pre-registered may do so the day of the distribution. They must bring proof of household income for the last 90 days and personal identification with them. Effective March 8, 1985, new income

guidelines were introduced for persons 60 years of age and older as well as persons under 60 years of age. People must attend the same site as stated on the front of their Commodity Food Registration Card. Registration does not guarantee receipt of commodity food each time. Due to the limited quantity of surplus food, the distribution is on a first-come, first-served basis. Public distribution site for the Farmington area is St. Alexander's Church, 27855 Shawwassee, Farmington Hills on Aug. 27 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

If you are homebound or unable to pre-register at the distribution site, you may call either OLHSA's toll free number 1-800-482-9250 for those persons who must call long distance, or the local Pontiac area number 858-5180. For more information regarding the distribution, you may call Oakland County Field Services office nearest your home: 624-5520 for Walled Lake and the Northwest and Southwest Oakland County areas, or 399-2880 for Hazel Park and the Southeast and Northeast Oakland County areas.


