Symphony calls young musicians

Livonia Youth Symphony Society (LYSS) is calling for young musicians. The society, now in its 27th year and one of the best known of its type in the country, offers young musicians an opportunity, under professional leadership, to play changing music with others of similar age and interests.

"It's a fantastic opportunity for young musicians since very few schools throughout the area provide a symphonic orchestra opportunity," said Key Rowe, president of the society.

LYSS is comprised of three orchestras, accommodating young musicians at most any stage of their learning process. The string orchestra is comprised entirely of string instrumentalists. Ages of this group range from 5 through early teens. Requirements are that applicants have at least one year of private lessons.

The concert orchestra is the society's intermediate group while the symphony orchestra is comprised of the best musicians. Many of the musicians advance from each orchestra. Besides string musicians, brass and woodwind players and percussionists are invited to the concert and symphony orchestras.

"We do a lot of fun things during the season," said Rowe. "We play four concerts in this area culminated by a great concert at Detroit's Orchestra Hall. That alone, is a fantastic experience for any musician."

"Last year our symphony orchestra also traveled to Chicago to present concerts there, while the string orchestra spent a day in Ohio playing for three different audiences. We plan more this season," she added.

Among other activities, LYSS sponsors a scholarship competition for its orchestra members. Winners are presented cash awards that can be used for private study, music camp or equipment.

The society is made up of musicians from nearly 35 communities ranging from Detroit to from as far away as Ann Arbor and Toledo. The conductors are professionals who devote much time to this activity and who are well acquainted with much of the world's great music.
