TO THE ELECTORS OF THE FARMINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT, a constituent school district of the Oakland County Intermediate School District:

Notice is hereby given that a special election will be held in the Farmington School District as one of the constituent school districts of the Oakland County Intermediate School District on the 14th day of October, 1985, from seven o'clock in the forenoon to eight o'clock in the afternoon Eastern Daylight Time to vote upon the proposition of increasing the millage limit on the annual property tax levied for special education in the said Intermediate School District by three-quarters (¾) mill (seventy-five cents (\$75) per \$1,000 of the assessed valuation of property in the district, as equalized) over the existing one (1) mill limit heretofore authorized, pursuant to Resolution adopted April 23, 1985 by the Oakland Schools Intermediate School District, said proposition being set forth in the form of the following question:
