
"What we wanted to do was treat each window as a canvas," said Golden. The beveled glass dining room table top rests on dyed teal leather wedges which have their own sculptural quality.

Lattice gives stylish look

Are your guests and friends more entertained by the appearance of your family room or entertainment center than by your cooking or social graces? If so, it may be time to consider a bit of redecorating or remodeling. But it needn't be expensive, time consuming or elaborate, says the Wood Moulding and Miliwork Producers Association. Frequently, all it takes is some imagination and a touch of style to add a bit of visual impact here and the consequently. Consider the content of the c

screen, while others are decorative such as a wan design.

Lattice is easy to apply and can be formed into a number of different patterns. Among the most pop-

ular are horizontal and vertical crossbatch and diagonal crossbatch. Others include horizontal, vertical, diamond and herringbone.

Once you've decided which arrangement to use, be sure to measure and miler carefully. Then glue and nail the lattice in place and paint or stain it to match the decor.

Most home workshops have the tools needed for the job. They include a fine-tooth saw, a hammer, nail set, finishing nails, a tape measure, glue, sandpaper and wood filler and a miter box to make accurate 45-degree-angle cuts.

Lattice, the most widely used type of wood moulding, can be found at most local home centers, lumber yards and building supply centers.
