Farmington Hills has added three new voting precincts to it existing 24 precincts in time to accommodate roughly 41,000 registered voters in the Tuesday, Nov. 5, general election.

"We just had too much congestion in our poiling places," said Farmington Hills City Clerk JoAn Reynolds.

In the past year, the number of regis-tered voters has increased by about 1,500, she added.

1,500, she added. Even though the number of voters expected to turn out for the city council election will be no where near the num-bers that voted in last year's presiden-tial election, Reynolds said she believes the city's 27 precincts can handle any size turnout.

"It makes sense to make the move in a smaller (election) year," Reynolds said.

Adding new precincts during a presidential or state election can create havoc. Making the changes during the city council election gives voters time to become accustomed to where they should vole when the next big election comes up, she said.

HEADQUARTERS FOR the three new precincts will be in Hope Lutheran Church, 39200 12 Mile, Universalist Un-itarian Church, 25301 Halsted, and Power Middle School, 34740 Rhons-

wood.
Precinct 12 (Hope Lutheran Church)
will accommodate voters south of 13
Mile and west of Drake. They previously voted at Farmington Hills Fire
Headquarters, 28711 Drake.

Precinct 27 (Universalist Unitarian Church) will accommodate voters at Mutrwood Apartments. They previous-ly voted at the Independence Green Clubhouse, near Grand River and Halsted.

Precinct 1 (Power Middle School) will accommodate voters south of 9 Mile, between Middlebelt on the east and Halsted on the west. They previ-ously voted at Gill Elementary School, 21195 Gill.

Other changes include switching the location of precincts 6 and 9. Voters in Precinct 6 will vote at Larkshire Elementary School, 23800 Tuck, instead of East Middle School. Voters in Precinct 9 will vote at East Middle School, 25000 Middlebelt, instead of Larkshire Elementary.

The city clerk's staff is also updating the absentee voter list. The city main-tains a mailing list of all voters older than 60. Voters on this list automatically receive a request for an ab ballot application, Reynolds said.

IN THE next few months, voters will receive a postcard in the mail asking if they want to remain on the automatic list, Reynolds said. They are to send the answered postcard back to city hall. Those who wish to remain on the list will automatically receive an absence ballot, Reynolds said.

"If you don't respond, you'll be dropped from the list," she said.

Voters who ask that their name be dropped from the list may later be asked for it to be added should they be unable to attend the polis, Reynolds added.


