- Inspector Thomas Godwin, moving from records and communication to the operations bureau.
- Inspector Richard Niemela, moving from the administrative and special services bureau to the records and communications bureau.
- Capt. Russell Conway, moving from the position of operations bureau executive officer to head of the patrol division operations bureau.
- Lt. Norman Kilmer, moving from

the traffic division to the special operations division.

- Richard Murphy, promoted from sergeant to lieutenant, moving from the juvenile division to the investigative division.
- Sgt. Martin Bledsoe, moving from the Special Patrol Operations Team (SPOT) unit to the traffic section.
- Charles Nebus, promoted from patrol officer to sergeant, moving from the detective division to the juvenile division.
- Sgt. Dennis Rochford, moving from communications to the detective division.
- Sgt. Joseph Rebb, moving from the patrol division to the communications section.
- Sgt. Albert Havner, moving from the patrol division to the SPOT unit.
- James Whitcomb, promoted from patrol officer to sergeant, moving from the support shift to the patrol division-shift 3.

"THEY (DEPARTMENT employees) see movement," Dwyer said. "They see upward mobility. And that's important. They see the transfer of individuals. They see a lot of people being moved into different areas of the department. People can get stunted. They can get stagnant."

The reorganization, Dwyer said, will make the department "more efficient and responsive to the community and gives a good span of control accountability. This is a very workable plan."

It streamlines the various bureaus and divisions within the department. For example, as the department has grown it has become difficult for one person to directly supervise both the patrol and traffic functions.

As a result, Dwyer has assigned the operations bureau captain to handle only the patrol division instead of all the functions that were previously under this bureau.

Organizational changes include taking the SPOT unit from under the ad-

ministration and special services bureau and making it independent under the deputy chief's authority.

THE NEW administrative/investigative bureau will include personnel services, training, budget and purchasing, planning, the investigative division, and the detective, juvenile and crime prevention sections. The investigative division will include the detective, juvenile and crime prevention sections.

THE OPERATIONS bureau will include the patrol division and special operations division. The special operations division will be responsible for traffic, warrants, vehicle maintenance and auxiliary officers.

The auxiliary officers have been transferred to the patrol division so they can work in cooperation with the regular patrol officers. Under Nicola's plan, the auxiliary officers were under the administration and special services bureau. The patrol division was under the operations bureau.

The records and communications bureau will include jail administration, building maintenance, communications, property, records and subpoena services.

a legal opinion because I felt as though I was not required to resign because the library is a separate authority," Grant said Friday.

"The Farmington Community Library is a district library, formed under Public Act 184. Under this act, the library operates under its own authority, autonomous from both municipalities. Although appointed by the mayor, trustees do not serve as city officials," Grant wrote in a letter to Dolan requesting a legal opinion.

BUT IN his opinion, Bibeau wrote that the day-to-day operations of the library are independent of both the Farmington and Farmington Hills city councils.

The two councils provide funding to the library, appoint trustees to the library board and regulate the number of trustees who are on the board. The library system's activities are controlled by the two councils to the extent of the amount of funding provided, Bibeau said.
