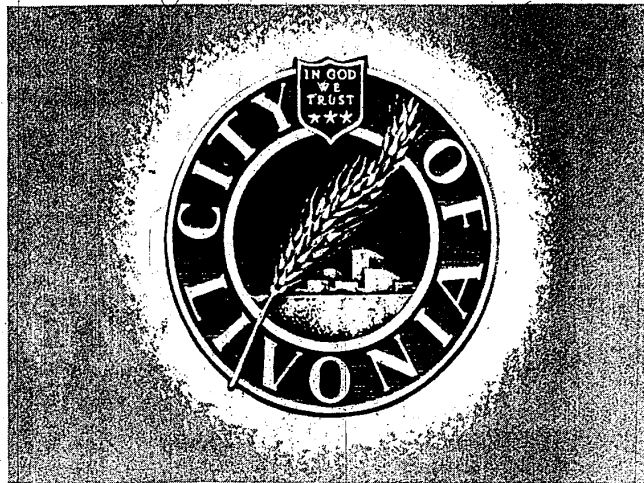
## Veterans-Festival Day Sunday, Sept. 13
