

# Library hosts book sale

More than 10,000 collectible books and print items will be offered for sale at the 10th Annual Midwest Antiquarian and Collectible Book Sale, at the Detroit Public Library 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Friday and Saturday, Oct. 25, 26.

There will be 25 private bookdealers displaying and selling wares at the main library 3201 Woodward, Detroit. Collectible and antiquarian books and print materials, autographs, graphics, illustrations, posters, and reference material will be available.

Prices will range from inexpensive to expensive. This event affords an exceptional opportunity for the novice collector to examine a wide variety of print materials and to query a number of specialty bookdealers on the "in and out" of book collecting.

The sponsors, The Friends of the Library will have a sale booth with more than a thousand donated items selling at special bargain prices. Proceeds from the sale of these items will be used to benefit the Detroit Public Library.

There is no admission charge to the sale area and no advance preview will be held. Sale booths are on the Cass Avenue side of the Library in the concourse area on two floors.

Underground parking is available across the street from the main library in the Cultural Center Garage, just south of the Detroit Institute of Arts at Woodward Avenue and Farmsworth.






