

Bailey is charged in 1984 murder

A 16-year-old teen can give police investigators something two other teenagers, Kenneth Meyers and Shawn Moore, can't. The youth can identify the man who, in 1984, abducted him.

Ronald Lloyd Bailey, 26, of Livonia has been charged with the kidnapping and murder of both Kenneth, 14, and Shawn, 13, as well as the kidnap and sexual assault of the Livonia youth.

Kenneth's body was found July 18, 1984 in Hines Park, about two miles from Bailey's parents' home on Scone.

Shawn's body was found Sept. 13, 1985 in a wooded area near Gladwin, near a cabin owned by a friend of Bailey's.

The youth kidnapped from the Livonia Mall and assaulted was released unharmed.

According to sources close to the investigation, the abductor threatened to kill the youth and members of his family if he told of the crime. The sources said the abductor knew both the youth and his family.

The youth's mother apparently forced her son to report the crime to Livonia police. Police apparently spent many hours convincing the boy he should talk before he would.

LAST THURSDAY, Bailey was charged in Westland District Court with the kidnapping and murder of Kenneth Meyers. He was charged in Livonia District Court with the kidnap

and first-degree criminal sexual assault of the youth in Livonia. The crimes occurred in 1984 within a five-week period.

Bailey earlier was charged with the slaying of Shawn Moore, who was abducted in Green Oak Township Aug. 31 while riding his bicycle. He is being held in the Livingston County Jail.

Bailey, clad in bright orange jail coveralls with the words "Livingston County Jail" printed on the back, said nothing at either arraignment last Thursday.

His attorneys, Raymond Caesar and Charles Murphy of Farmington Hills, entered a plea of not guilty in both cases. The attorneys told both judges that Bailey would not answer to the charges. They also waived court rules requiring preliminary examinations within 12 days of arraignment.

BAILEY was arraigned at 9 a.m. before Westland District Judge Thomas Smith on charges of premeditated murder in the first degree, felony murder and kidnapping of Kenneth Meyers.

The youth was kidnapped from a parking lot near his Ferndale home on July 16, 1984. Witnesses said the abductor was driving a brown station wagon. Kenneth's body was found two days later in Hines Park.

Smith ordered psychiatric testing to determine "mental competency and criminal responsibility" and set a Dec. 2 preliminary examination.

Bailey was then whisked to Livonia District Court, where he was arraigned shortly after 10 a.m. before Judge Herbert Brzezinski on kidnapping and sexual assault charges stemming from the June 7, 1984 abduction of the youth from the Livonia Mall.

Brzezinski, who set a Nov. 22 preliminary exam, also ordered a psychiatric examination of Bailey.

The youth kidnapped from the mall was driven to Hines Park in a brown station wagon and forced to drink two beers. The kidnapper allegedly performed a sex act on him and then released him.

Northville State Police have been examining a 1970 brownish-gold Buick station wagon once owned by Bailey and now impounded at the post.

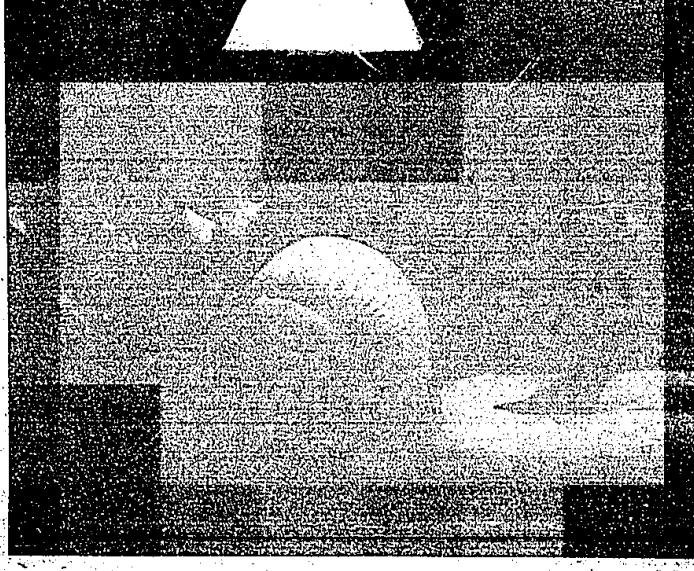
