The university is also asking for also million of its \$25 million request in fiscal 1986-87.



SCHOOL trustees have also requested an appropriation of \$22,820,000 for the state's 1980-87 fiscal year, an increase of 17.5 percent over current funding. The request was approved on Oct. 9.


