Each year, as a public service, the Observer &

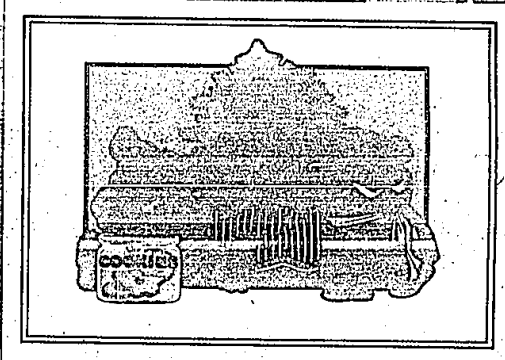
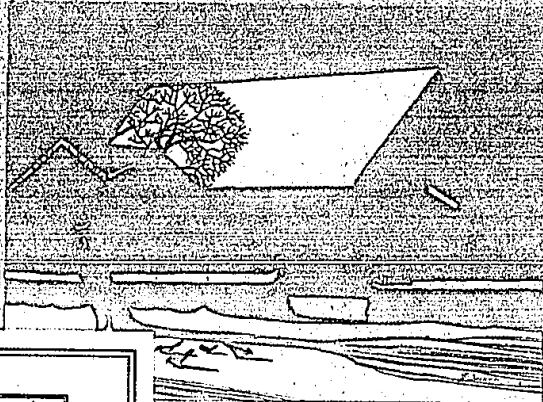
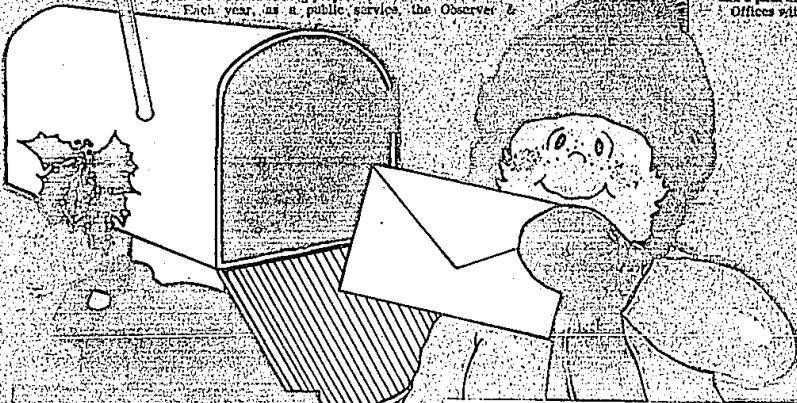
Eccentric aids these organizations by publishing a page of some of the cards being offered. This year, for the first time, they are in full color.

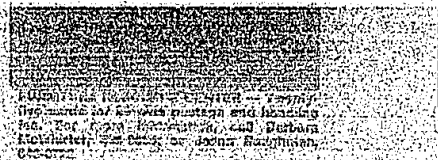
