

Night of awards

Chamber of Commerce lauds its veterans

It was a night of awards. After bestowing honors on Jean Fox — Citizen of the Year (Page 1A) — the Farmington-Farmington Hills Chamber of Commerce honored some of its own Tuesday evening at the 23rd Annual Business Meeting and Awards Dinner at the Botsford Inn in Farmington Hills.

Before 120 guests, including representatives of the Farmington Hills City Council, Farmington City Council and Farmington Board of Education, the chamber saluted and bid farewell to several of its veteran board members.

Leading the list of honorees was Russ Tuttle — immediate past president — who was saluted for his year of leadership 1984-85.

Lauding Tuttle for his leadership, current chamber president John Handley said the chamber's success "was in no small measure attributed to Russ' year of service."

Headlining the evening as speaker was Martha Seger, an Oakland County native and current member of the Federal Reserve Board of Governors.

Seger, also a voting member of the Federal Open Market Commission, provided guests with her views of the current economic situation and outlook of the future.

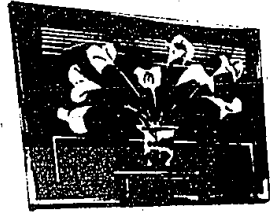

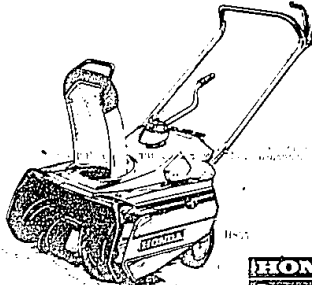
