'84 Olympics was smashing

Thirty new Olympic and 10 world records were smashed at the 1984 Summer Games in Angeles. The U.S. men's 400-meter relay ran 37.83 seconds to eclipse the 1980 world mark. Swimming also set the pace with a dozen new Olympic records. American athletes topped the medal list with 174, and the largest Olympic crowd ever — more than 5.5 million — attended the 16-day festival of amateur sports.

To develop a mobile security force, Olympic officials called the aid of more than 400 motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) for Olympic sites and villages. ATVs allowed the security force to maneuver in heavy foot traffic and use fewer people to patrol large stadiums such as the Rose Bowl or Coliseum.
