

Alice Nichols, who was named "Artist-in-Residence" by Farmington Area Arts Commission in 1982, has won the top award in the fourth annual Helen L. De Roy Art Competition on Orchard Ridge Campus, Oakland Community College.

The Farmington artist won for her 30-by-40-inch watercolor of a carousel called "Full Circle." Entries in the competition remain on display in the Wallace Smith Theatre Art Gallery and can be seen weekdays from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. and 6:30-8 p.m. Wednesdays through Dec. 4.

"Full Circle" will become part of the college's permanent collection. Almost simultaneously with the announcement of this win, Nichols learned she had taken the second-place spot in Farmington Artists Club's fall show for her work called "Another Pretty Face." The local club's exhibit runs from Friday through Sunday in Mercey Center.

Chairman for the De Roy art competition is Kegham Tazian of the college's art faculty. Juror for the competition was Zubei Khatchatourian, painter, lecturer and former instructor of drawing a Wayne State University.

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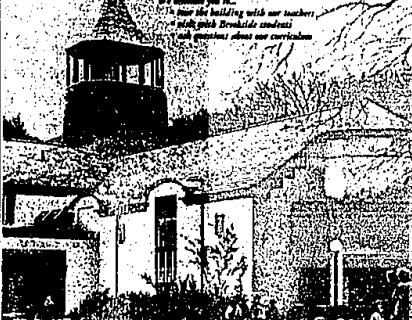
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
