## Seatbelt helps save a life, police say

The Farmington Hills woman who died from a head injury incurred in a two-car, head-on collision Nov. 25 on Middlebelt, south of the I-696 overpass, didn't appear to be wearing a seatbelt, police said. The other driver, who police said was belted, was discharged from Providence Hospital, Southfield, Nov. 28. "We feel the seatbelt

saved the man's life. It prevented him from taking the steering column in the chest or going through the windshield," Police Lt. Norman Kilmer said. The woman, Kohar Mardirossian, 42, was driving a Ford Cougar (left). The man, Alvin L. Kushner, 59, of Southfield was driving a Ford LTD (right). "It looks like his car

sustained a lot more damage," Kilmer said. The woman was southbound on Middlebelt shortly before 8 p.m. when her car crossed the center line, striking Kushner's car, police said. They attribute the collision to icy road conditions and freezing rain.
