New home for aged eyed for the Hills

The developer of a new 59-bed bome for the aged in Farmington Hills will submit a revised project plan to the state this week.

This action follows recent notification of plan disapproval by the Michigan Department of Public Health (MDPH).

(MDPH).
Detroit Baptist Manor hopes to build the new Hayworth Center for Medium Care at 30301 13 Mile on company property next to occupied senior citizen apartments, duplexes and quadriplex units.

The privately funded and private-pay facility is expected to cost \$173,500 and take about one year to build.

"They (the state) were willing to work with us," said Robert McQuald, executive director of Farmington Hills-based Baptist Manor. Manor representatives met with De-

ACCORDING TO MDPH information, the per-bed project costs were too
high and space planning did not meet
state-planning policles for aged home
facilities.

An MDPH spokeswoman confirmed
that no official appeal of the ruling had
been illed with the state.

McQuald said plans paralleled those
for a nursing home, for which the area
now has too many beds. "We have a
need for this level of care in Farmington Hills," he said of beds for the aged.
"They (the state) were concerned we
would attempt to convert the facility to
a nursing home."
