AMONG THE MORE welcome son, place your poinsettia in a sunny gifts over the Christmas season are window but make sure it doesn't window but make sure it doesn't suffer temperatures lower than 62 F (18 C) by night nor higher than 72
F (22 C) by day.

If you can't be certain it won't be

too chilly at night, then move your too chilly at night, then move your plant back into the room. Similarly, use warm tap water to moisten the soil thoroughly, but only when the soil feels dry to the touch.

When the colored bracts start fall-

ing, sometime in the next six weeks or so, don't fret for this is the plant's natural resting period and a very crucial time insofar as caring for it. It should be moved to a cool place and the watering reduced until the soil is almost bone dry.
