City sidewalk program moves along



The city council has tabled the issue of sidewalk instal-lation on Freedom Road, west of Fermington Road, into a wooded area owned by the Huron River Hunting and Fishing Club.

The 1985 Farmington aldewalk program is nearly done, but the weather may delay its completion until spring, Farmington City Manager Robert Deadman said.

City council approved initial payment of \$62,022 to Itala Construction of Sterling Heights Dec. 2. This represents 85 percent of the company's \$19,501 contract, awarded Aug. 2, with less 5 percent held until project completion.

The issue of installing sidewalks along westbound Freedom Road into a wooded area owned by the Huron River Huning and Fishing Citab was also raised by the council. The matter was tabled until spring pending cutdy by the city administration.

This area was considered for sidewalks in 1985, but installation was too expensive, Deadman said.

THIS YEAR'S project money comes from three sources: \$38,000 from a special assessment district, \$36,000 from the city's Community Development Block Grant fund, and the balance paid from the general fund.

NEXT YEAR, Farmington will survey sidewalts north of Grand River, with the exception of the Orchard Lake Road corridor. With discussion of widening of the county road, Deadman said the city will not install sidewalks only to have them possibly ripped up. "We don't want to pay for them twice," he said. Deadman sake residents to also do their own sidewalk surveys. According to city ordinance, residents are responsible and liable for maintenance on sidewalks located on their properly. They should be especially aware of bazards because of the liability," he added.

selves, most let the city do it occause it can obtain an all 1,000 square feet of replacement sidewalk was included in the 1935 city project. The city's ordinance regarding sidewalks was clarified last September, requiring property owners to keep sidewalks and diveway approaches in good repair.




