GIRLS BASKETBALL — Registration is being accepted for girls in grades 9 through 12 for an informal basketball league that will be played

on Saturdays. The program will run eight weeks beginning Saturday, Jan. 11. A \$15 registration fee can be paid at the recreation office. The deadline to register is Friday, Dec. 27.

TEEN SKIING — This popular program is quickly filling up. Openings for Session II only are still available for the pick-up sites at East Middle School and Farmington High School: Fridays, Jan. 24, 31 and Feb. 7. Buses leave at 4:30 p.m. and return approximately 10:15 p.m. A \$38-per-session fee in-

cludes tow ticket, lessons and transportation. Ski rental is extra. Ski area is Mount Brighton. You may register at the recreation office.

YOUTH BASKETBALL — Registration is still being accepted for the girls youth basketball program. All fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth graders are eligible to participate. Teams will be formed by geographic location and grade level. Games will be starting Saturday, Jan. 11. Registration fee is \$15.

SKI LEAGUE — Boys and girls 7-13 years of age can join this specially designed league that will help children learn and provide the basic techniques of cross country skiing, races, games, club patch and more. The league will be run 9:30-11:30 a.m. Saturdays, Jan. 4, 11 and 18 at the Glen Oaks Ski Center. Registration fee is \$25 with rental, \$15 with your own equipment.

CROSS COUNTRY — The Recreation Division will be offering Cross Country Ski Lessons at the Glen Oaks Ski Center. Lessons will be available on

the weekends for beginners and intermediate skiers at 10 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. All lessons are 1½ hours long. The fee for the lessons will be \$11, including ski rental, \$6 with your own equipment. Pre-register at the recreation office.

ICE SKATING — Learn to ice skate or improve your skating techniques. Classes meet for 30 minutes once a week for six weeks 7:30-8 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 7 and at 3:30 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 11 for children. Rental skates are

available. All lessons will be held at Beech Woods Area. Fee is \$25.

YOUTH BAND — Individuals presently in sixth through eighth grades are offered the opportunity to play in a concert band while acquainting them with contemporary musical literature. Lessons will be 4-5 p.m. Thursdays beginning Jan. 9 at Dunckel Middle School and continuing until March 20. Participants can register at the recreation office. Fee is \$15. All participants must furnish their own instruments.

Classes for the winter semester officially begin at 8 a.m. Saturday, Jan. 4.

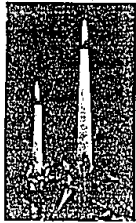
Students may register at any one of the following OCC campus locations: Auburn Hills Campus in Auburn Hills
