CROSS COUNTRY CLINICS — The Recreation Division along with the Detroit Free Press is sponsoring five cross country ski clinics this winter. The clinics will be on the following Saturdays, at the Glen Oaks Ski Center, from 8:30 to 10 a.m. on Jan. 11, 18, 25 and Feb. 1 and 8. The fee is \$10 per participant, per clinic and includes equipment rental, hour lesson and open skiing for half the day. The fee is \$5 with your own equipment.

CPR — This American Red Cross course is a nine-hour comprehensive class and refresher course. The session will run Tuesday, Jan. 21, Thursday, Jan. 23 and Tuesday, Jan. 28. Classes will be held in Dunckel Middle School from 7-10 p.m. The class fee is \$5 and includes books and handouts. Pre-registration is required for this class.

YOUTH BOWLING — In cooperation with Bel-Altare, Country and Norwest Lanes, a comprehensive bowling program for youth in grades 5-8 will teach correct lane approach, ball delivery, timing and scoring. Classes begin the week of Jan. 13 for one hour per week for eight weeks. A \$55 registration fee can be made at the recreation office.

HORSEBACK LESSONS — Learn the basic skills of riding through a western indoor riding lessons at the Windshire Equestrian Academy this winter. Classes for beginners, 8 years and older who have had previous riding lessons begin the week of Jan. 13 for one hour per week for eight weeks. A \$55 registration fee can be made at the recreation office.

CROSS COUNTRY SKI TOUR — Farmington area residents are joining a guided tour on the city's new 212-acre park, formerly known as the Spicer property. Limited space is available. Because of the hills in this park, participants must have cross country ski experience and no children under the age of 10 may participate. Tour dates and

times are Sunday, Jan. 19, and Sunday, Feb. 9, at 1 p.m. The \$2 registration fee should be made at the recreation office. Fee includes guide and hot refreshments. There will be no ski rental available.

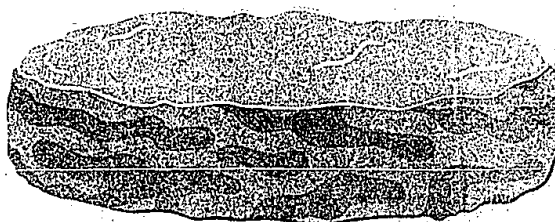
