

# Rate boost nearing for cable subscribers

The SWOCC has received notice from Metrovision of Oakland County that it will pay on a rate increase to subscribers effective Feb. 1.

The Cable Communication Policy Act of 1984 Section 6236 (1) allows for up to a 5-percent increase of basic cable rates in 1986 prior to rate determination in 1987. All other rates will remain the same.

The SWOCC continues to oversee the franchise ordinance and insist upon

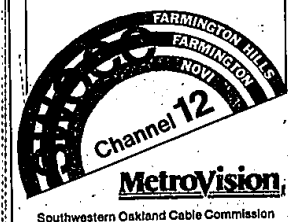

### CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 13, 1986

Mayor Alkateeb opened the regular meeting of the Farmington Hills City Council on January 13, 1986 at 7:30 p.m. Members present: Alkateeb, Dolan, Dudley, Marks, Sever, Soronen, and Wolf. Members absent: None. Others present: City Manager Costuck, City Clerk Reynolds, City Attorney Bibeau and Director of Public Services Blasek.

Minutes of December 16, 1985 are to be resubmitted with corrections.

The Annual Report for Fiscal Year 1984/85 for the Farmington Community Library was presented by Beverly Papal, Director.

Council enacted Ordinance No. C-1-85, Zoning Request 36-9-85, to rezone Lots 20 thru 21 and 39 thru 43 of Farmington Heights Subdivision in Section 11 from RA-4 to OS-1.

Council enacted Ordinance No. C-2-85, Zoning Request FC 42-10-85, to rezone 0.14 acres of land west of Middlebelt, south of Grand River in Section 35 from B-3 to RC-3. The request for an increase in the local supplement for salary increase for 47th District Court Judges was approved by Council.

Council approved the transfer of ownership of 1985 SDM licensed business located at 22200 Middlebelt from Sam Paires to Nabil and Summer Al-Osachi (Mid-Nine Market).

Request for a new 12 Month Resort Class C licensed business was approved for Bloomfield World of Foods, Inc. (Pudding's Restaurant), located on West 13 Mile Road, east of Orchard Lake Road.

Council introduced an amendment to the Penal Code, making it a misdemeanor to furnish false identification to a police officer.

Michigan Municipal League Region IV Meeting will be held on January 23, 1986 and the Annual Legislative Conference will be held on February 26, 1986.

Council established the date of February 17, 1986 for a public hearing to review the Community Block Grant Program for 1986/87.

Council approved to enter into an agreement with the developer of Quality Inn to permit an alternate sanitary sewer rate structure.

City Manager was authorized to proceed with the development of a plan for remodeling the old Police Building and City Hall and Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem and Councilmember Dolan were appointed to serve with members of City Staff on an ad hoc committee to develop such a plan.

Council approved the extension of the preliminary plat for Hunter's Pointe No. 3 until July 23, 1987.

Council adopted Resolution pertaining to the maintenance of drainage facilities within the Wayne County right-of-way.

Resolution was adopted authorizing the engineering for the 1986 road improvement program.

Traffic Control Order No. P-69-1986 was adopted, prohibiting parking on Nine Mile at Middlebelt.

Traffic Control Order No. ST-191-1986 was adopted, requiring all east and west bound traffic to stop at the intersection of Willow Lane and List.

Council approved the employment of Denise Mills in the Department of Special Services, in accordance with Section 10.01A of the City Code.

Meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
