Testing centers increase

Effective Jan. 1, most vehicles in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties must pass a state-mandated auto emissions test (AET) before plates or tabs will be issued.

Authorized AET facilities have personnel state trained to give the test, which takes about 10 minutes.

The facilities can charge no more than \$10 per test according to state law. AET centers will give the auto owner a receipt showing the approved emissions information, which must be presented when buying plates or tabs.
