One aspect of our civilization is the prevalence of substitutes and ar-tificial imitations for the real thing. Music is no exception.

Music is no exception.

In both the art of music writing as well as music performance one may encounter these artificial ingredients all too frequently. There are, of course, notable exceptions to down the preceeding caracterization doesn't apply.

Among the most distinguished in this category is Meastro Charles tool, the present conductor of the Mostreal Symphony. Another gifted artist in this category is planist Alexis Welssenberg, whose demand

by major orchestras and conductors is among the highest.
Comparing the latest Detroit Symphony Orchestra program featuring these distinguished guests with one that is merely routine would be like comparing pure Colombian coffece to a decaffenated brand. The items on the program were all familiar ones — the Overture to "Beatice and Benedict" by Berlioz, Chopin's Piano Concerto No. 1 in E minor and "The Rite of Spring" by Stravinsky.
While the material was old-fastioned, the freshness of the aroma tended to rekindle one's appreciation for these works, which are often taken for granted.

Even the Berlioz short overture

made a significant impact, empha-sizing this composer's keen ability of orchestration. The Chopin concer-tor presented a rare display of artis-tic treasure. It could be compared to a gem, delicate and fragile, yet full of substance. When examining such a preclous gem under a microscope, the detec-tion of some flaws is inevitable. Likewise, Weissenberg's playing had

some imperfections manifested by some occasional missed notes, but these were of the kind that are noticed only by hardcore critics.

The well shaped and delicate phrases flowed with rich, fruitful abundance. There was an extremely tender expressiveness in the slow movement on one hand, and a darzling display of technique in the coda to the final movement on the other.

All this was supplemented by fine

All this was supplemented by fine orchestral support. Chopin was no-torious for being a mediocre orchestrator and frequently it is my feeling that one could dispense with the orchestra in this particular work without much darnage. This, however, was not the case with this per-

formance.

"The Rite of Spring," in spite of the popularity it has gained since its writing more than seven decades ago, its still not fully understood by many. Its portrayal of primitive dances makes it sound more contemporary than some works writen just recently.

However, the intricate rhythrale patterns and ingenitus instrumental combinations turn it into a most challonging work — and a most rewarding listening experience when properly executed.

Dutoit appeared to be intimately familiar with the coxact entrance of each intermediate score. Its knowledge sound is the sound of the sound in the

sounds. The DSO musicians, who have performed the work endless times and recorded it under Dorati are, of course, familiar with it themselves.
Under Dutoit the sound was unlited and integrated, making the listener feel the full impact of this difficult work. This isn't meant to suggest that this latest performance was superior to that under Dorati — as a rule I try to stay away from such comparisons.
To return to our coffee analogy, there are several different superior brands with different tastes. Only the decaffeinated brands seem to have the same bland taste. Hopefully, we shall be treated to many more refills with Maestro Charles Dutoit.
