

Man charged with possession of stolen car

A police officer required hospital treatment and three unmarked police cars were damaged in the apprehension of two men, one of whom was charged with possession of a car stolen from the Quality Inn at 12 Mile and Orchard Lakes roads early Tuesday.

The man driving the stolen car, a Chevrolet Camaro Z-28 valued at \$18,000, also was injured, Farmington Hills police said.

Arraigned Tuesday before District Judge Michael Hand of Farmington, William Calvin Bond Jr., 21, of Ann Ar-

bor, pleaded not guilty to one count of receiving and concealing stolen property, a felony, and fleeing and eluding, a misdemeanor. Conviction would bring a penalty of up to five years in prison on the first count and up to one year in prison on the second.

Arraigned before District Judge Margaret Schaeffer of Farmington, William Kelly Davis, 18, of Ypsilanti, stood mute to carrying a pistol in a vehicle, a felony carrying up to five years in prison upon conviction.

Bond was set at \$1,000 for each de-

fendant pending a preliminary examination in 47th District Court.

FARMINGTON HILLS Officer Charles Hubbard said that while in an unmarked car, he spotted two cars going erratically on southbound Orchard Lake Road shortly past midnight. The cars, the Camaro and a Pontiac 6000, were the kind often stolen from apartments along 12 Mile, he said.

Suspicious of the movement of the cars and the actions of the drivers,

Hubbard said he followed as the cars entered eastbound I-696 and stayed near each other at speeds of up to 80 mph.

A marked unit from Southfield stopped the Pontiac on I-696 near Mount Vernon. In pursuit of the Camaro were unmarked units from Farmington Hills and Southfield.

But as a marked Southfield unit pulled behind the Camaro and turned on its overhead lights, the Camaro accelerated, Farmington Hills Sgt. Al Haver said.

About the same time, the driver of

the Camaro lost control and veered to the left, just missing Haver's car. It hit the unmarked Southfield unit and just missed the barrier in the freeway median, Haver said.

THE CAR THEN veered in front of Haver's, went across three lanes and up the south embankment, spun and re-entered the freeway, hitting Haver's car on the passenger side. It then spun, hit the front of Haver's car, bounced off, ran into the passenger side of Farmington Hills Officer Al Soder-

lund's unmarked car and hit the unmarked Southfield unit a second time. The Camaro came to a stop in the freeway's center lane, Haver said.

Bond suffered head injuries and sought medical treatment later. Soderlund was treated at Providence Hospital, Novi, for a back injury, Farmington Hills Sgt. Charles Nebus said.

Police said they found the Camaro's steering column pried open. In the Pontiac 6000, they said they found a revolver in a magazine holder in front of Davis.

Free health tests available

Free health-screening tests worth \$150 will be available to the public at no cost during Project: Health-O-Rama at Providence Hospital Novi Center from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday, April 13.

Included will be testing for height/weight, vision, glaucoma, testicular and prostate cancer, oral cancer, skin cancer, blood pressure and hearing.

Pap smears will be given and a film on breast self-examination will be shown. Assessment of foot problems will be made by a physician. Counseling will be available on nutrition, medication and med-

ical problems. Pulmonary function tests will be offered.

Available for a small fee will be a blood chemistry panel for \$8 and colon cancer detection kits for \$2. People planning on having the full blood panel should not eat for four hours prior to the test.
