

# Students score high in state music meet

North Farmington High School music students captured 34 event Michigan Solo and Ensemble Festival and came home winners on all fronts. The students were given nine 1 Division ratings and five II Division ratings on the 1-V rating scale. Students in grades 10-12 are required to perform proficiency examinations where they can earn a total of 100 points. A score between 85-100 merits the I Division rating and a score between 70-84 rates the II Division rating.

The contest invites people of all age groups to submit entries of any common format, audio, visual or written, pertaining to original research on Farmington history.

The emphasis is on material concerning day to day life, material which is easily lost to future generations, but which if preserved, presents the humanistic record of real life situations. Recollections of family and friends are especially sought

since no other record may exist of their experiences.

Sources may be personal recollections, interviews, family diaries or letters, or old photographs, paintings and sketches. As much as possible, source material should be contemporary or near to the era depicted in the entry.

Judging will be based on historical interest, originality, quality and age category, which consists of grades 1-5, grades 6-8, grades 9-12 and college and adult divisions.


