In addition, a record 23,000 new
businesses of all types began in the
state during the past year. "It was
not an accident," Blanchard sald,
"We are now the third (largest) in
the nation for new businesses."
Blanchard was given the award

1985, reducing franchise registration
costs by an estimated 100 percent — a
"national model" law, Under the

pays a 4250 service fee and supplies
mandatory disciosures to the
franchise purchasers.


