Council will consider the 1986-87 federal Community Development Block Grant program, a major road improvement program, and will receive the 1986-87 operating and capital budgets, as well as the updated six-year capital improvement program.

Also to be considered are road improvements for Westgate Road, South Brook Lane, North Brook Lane and Richmond Hill Road in Westgate Franklin Village subdivision. Road improvements for Edmonston, Kirby and Cass in Farmington Acres subdivision will also be considered.

Amendments to zoning ordinances that are expected to be enacted include rezoning of property on the east side of Haggerty, north of Nine Mile, from RA-2 to OS-4; rezoning of property on the east side of Haggerty, south of Nine Mile, from RA-1 to OS-4; and rezoning of property on the north side of 12 Mile, east of Haggerty from RA-1 to RP-1.

Council will consider a site plan for multiple units in Farmington Ridge subdivision, a storm sewer enclosure on Freedom Road, near Gill, increasing water rates, and maintaining sewer rates.
