Carolyn was nominated by her art teacher, Sue Young, and is among less than 10 percent of all American high school students recognized by the Academy "for their dedication to excellence and achievement," according to executive director George Stevens.

She is eligible to apply for one of numerous college scholarships granted annually by the Academy.

In addition, Carolyn will be included in the Academy's 1986 Yearbook of National Award winners.
