● TENNIS LESSONS

The basic fundamentals of tennis are stressed while participants sharpen their tennis skills. Session 1 runs from May 10 to June 7 on Saturdays at Farmington High School. Class members provide their own

tennis racket, all-purpose athletic shoes and a can of new balls for the session. Children, teen and adult classes are forming.

● GOLF LESSONS

Improve your golf game by learning the proper stance for the game as well as the correct method of holding and swinging a golf club. Session 1 runs from May 20 to June 12. Children, teens, adults and senior adults may all take lessons. When lessons are scheduled at a driving range, each participant will be asked to buy a bucket of golf balls. Fee for one session of golf lessons is \$22 or \$12 for seniors.

● BASEBALL TRIPS

Travel to Tiger Stadium Friday, June 6, to see the Tigers take on the Toronto Blue Jays. Only preregistration is necessary by May 16 for \$2 entrance fee. Fee at the door is \$3. State rental is available on site for \$1.

● ROLLER SKATING

Area elementary-age children are invited to dress up as their favorite circus character and roller skate around the Bonaventure Skating

Rink 4-6 p.m. Wednesday, May 21. Clown face painting, games and prizes are all available. Preregistration is necessary by May 16 for \$2 entrance fee. Fee at the door is \$3. State rental is available on site for \$1.

● VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE

Teams interested in playing in a newly formed outdoor volleyball league are invited to an informational meeting 7 p.m. Tuesday, May 20, at the Farmington Community Library-Hills branch, 32737 12 Mile. Mens, womens and coed divisions are all available. A league schedule, entry fees and registration dates will

be discussed at the meeting.

● DISCOUNT TICKETS

A variety of admission tickets at a discount to residents are offered through the Farmington Hills Department of Special Services in cooperation with the Michigan Recreation and Park Association. Tickets are on sale at the City of Farmington Hills Recreation Division office and the City of Farmington Hills Finance Department from May 1 through Sept. 2.

● SAFETY TOWN

Safety Town, a pre-school safety education program, teaches partici-

pants pedestrian, motorist, bus, bicycle, railroad crossing, play, fire and home safety through child participation and demonstrations. Interaction with police, strangers and drug handlers is also discussed.

In addition, movies, songs, practice safety training and bus trip to the Farmington Hills Fire Department Headquarters reinforce what is taught during Safety Town sessions. Safety Town, conducted at Alameda School, is designed for participants entering kindergarten in the fall, however, any 4-6-year-old will be accepted. Registration for residents is being accepted. Non-residents may begin registration on May 15.
