FUR INSTANCE, if you wanted to find all the electric utility companies that now had a dividend yielding 7 percent or more and also had the rereased their dividend each year for the past five years by 5 percent or more a year, you would be able to plug into a data bank and get that information printed out on your computer in just a few minutes.

You then could review each of those companies individually to de-cide which ones might be the best in-

vestments.

There are programs for computers that will help you make a fundamental analysis of an individual company. Some of the best use NAIC's individual company analysis technique.

IN USING a computer this way you have to be careful. Look at the individual figures to see what has happened between the figures you be upon with and the answers you are getting. NAIC's procedure requires you to do this.

The basic point is that a computer can show you two companies that each have a 15 percent compounded growth rate for the last five years, but that are very different in how they have grown.

ONE COMPANY may have grown regularly at 15 percent a year, the kind of consistency investors like to see. The other may have done poorly for four years and then have gone

from nothing to a figure that produces a good average.

If you are a technician the computer will be very helpful in churning out the numbers you need. The size of your account is also a factor. The larger it is, the more helpful a computer can be in the basic task of ... keeping records.
