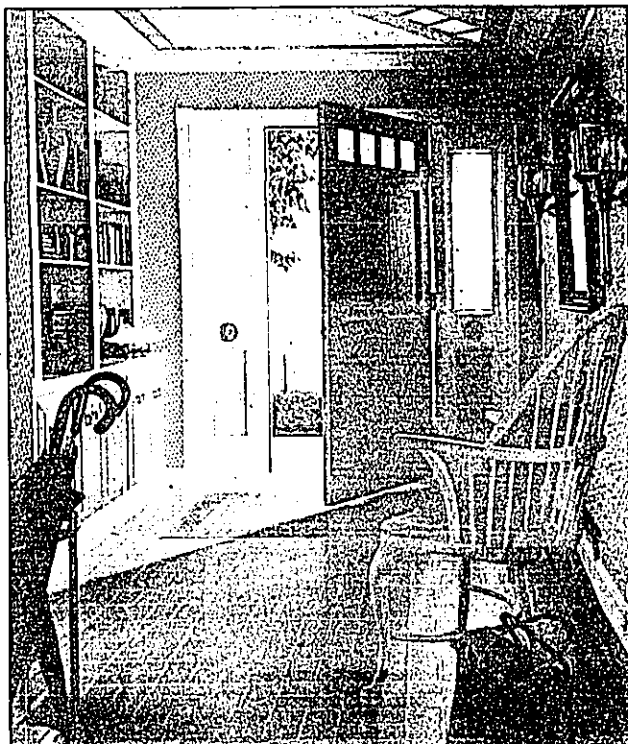




Foyer furnishings

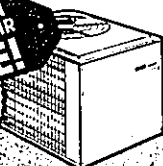
