May 11-17 is "National Hospital Week."

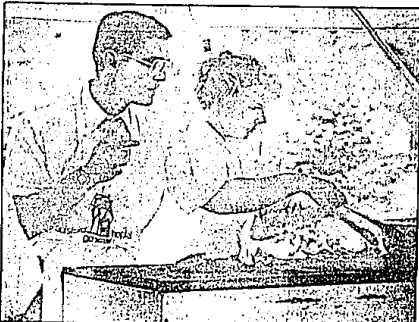
In recognition of this annual celebration, members of the Botsford General Hospital administration and management served a Bar-b-que dinner to all employees and volunteers.

dogs, baked beans, salad and ice cream.

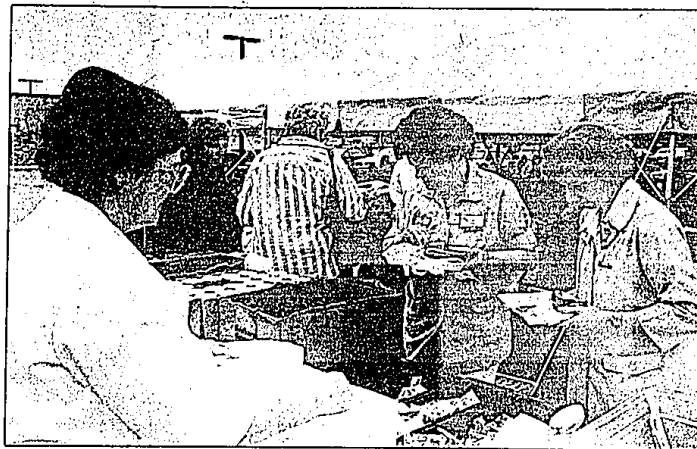
