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CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING MAY 27, 1986

Mayor Alkateer opened the regular meeting of the Farmington Hills City Council on May 27, 1986 at 7:30 p.m. Members present: Alkateer, Donald, Dostley, Clark Reynolds, and City Attorney Bibeau. Mayor presented a letter of Commendation to Department of Special Services for an Award of Merit from the Parks Maintenance and Grounds Management Division for the City's Park Maintenance Building. Minutes of May 8, 1986 were approved as presented and Minutes of May 12, 1986 were approved as amended. Council denied introduction of Amendment to Farmington Hills Host Ordinance, Section 80.455 (4) of Chapter 80 of City Code. Pay schedule for election workers was revised to \$80.00 per day for all election workers and \$75.00 per day for Chairpersons. Request of proponent was approved to withdraw zoning application of Coral Development, Inc. (Zoning Request 9-3-86, south side of 14 Mile, east of Farmington Road). Council introduced Amendment Ordinance accepting the Gravin House, located at 30757 Hillside Road, into the Farmington Hills Historic District. Council introduced Ordinance authorizing City Manager to Quit Claim Deed a reservation of drain and utility easements. Resolution was adopted approving ballot language for Special Election for Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem in amount of \$7,000,000 and date of September 23, 1986 was confirmed. Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem were designated as voting Delegate and Alternate for Annual Meeting of Michigan Municipal League. EDC Resolution No. 3 was adopted, setting public hearing date of June 23, 1986 for Milliken Development Company project. Consideration of EDC Resolution No. 3 for P.A.C. Associates Project was deleted from agenda at request of proponent. EDC Resolution No. 3 was adopted, setting public hearing date of June 23, 1986 for Willowgreen Building Group project (formerly Hills Tech Center Associates). David A. Dodge was reappointed to Cable Access Committee for three year term to expire 5-9-89 and Diana Thornhill was appointed for a three year term Robert Pratt was appointed Planning Commission liaison for Historic District Commission. Council approved Fund Raising Walk on June 1, 1986 for Church World Services. Contract for Pavement Striping Program was awarded to Continental Contracting, Inc. in amount of \$24,000. Council adopted S.A.D. Resolution No. 1, outlining the proposed assessment district for road improvements for Drake Road, Thirteen Mile to Fourteen Mile Roads, and adopted S.A.D. Resolution No. 2, setting public hearing date for June 16, 1986. Council adopted S.A.D. Resolution No. 1, outlining the proposed assessment district for road improvements for Thirteen Mile Road, Drake to Halsted, and adopted S.A.D. Resolution No. 2, setting public hearing date for June 16, 1986. Resolution was adopted authorizing application to the State of Michigan, Department of Natural Resources for conveyance of land to City for future drainage improvements. Council awarded bid to Red Holman GMC, in amount of \$12,150 for purchase of three Engineering vehicles. Traffic Control Order No. T34-19-1986 was adopted, prohibiting left turns at all times from westbound Grand River Avenue to southbound Freedom Road. Issuance of purchase order was approved for acquisition of IBM copier in amount of \$12,600. Council approved Joint Northwestern Highway Study Committee on roads with West Bloomfield. Meeting adjourned at 10:18 p.m.
