Hundreds apply for police cadet positions

The selection process has begun for the Farmington Hills Police Department's revived cadet program, scheduled to begin in September.

More than 400 applications for three cadet positions have been received. Of the total, 311 applicants

nave seen seneduled to take a law enforcement examination Saturday, June 7, Police Chief William Dwyer sald.

The cadet program provides young men and women interested in a law enforcement career an opportunity to get their feet in the door by training prior to assuming full duties

of sworn officers, Dwyer said.
The program is designed to offer
cadets 2-5 years of training and
work experience to prepare them —
as openings occur — to be selected
as own officers, Dwyer said.
Following Saturday's written
exam, top applicants will face an
oral board exam. Those who score in

the top parts of both the written and oral tests will face psychological testing, followed by physical and agility festing. "Based on all these factors, an eligibility list will be made in rank order," Dwyer added.

FINANCING of the revived cadet

FINANCING of the revived cadet program is included in the city's proposed 1984-87 budget along with the biring of four additional sworn police officers in August and another two in January 1987. Cadets will earn an annual starting salary of \$15.200, plus benefits. Cadets will be oligible for educational reimbursement for an associate value of the police administration or other field that would beneficial to the police department. Sworn officers are required to have aminimum two years of college.

CADETS, WHO must be at least 1714-years-old, will be assigned to the department's patrol division, and detective, communication and prop-

the program to keep pace with the growing community and expected increased activity in the new police facility, Dwyer said.

"The duties involved will be diversified and directed toward exposing the police cadet to assorted work areas and assignments within the department, designed to give the cade a well-rounded exposure and appreciation of the law enforcement process and the duties performed by police officers," Dwyer said. This would be accomplished by allowing the cade to perform work tasks that do not require the use of full police powers."

Cadet duties in these sections will include assisting in the dispatch center, processing prisoners, writing reports, processing abandoned vehicles, school crossing guard duties, and helping residents at the command desk, Dwyer said.

"It's going to be very productive as far as serving the community," Dwyer said. "We need every (sworn) officer we have available on patrol. We don't want to have sworn officers inside taking reports, doing clerical inside taking reports, doing clerical

Farmington Itilis offered the cadet program in the late 1960s and early 1970s, when it was financed through the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA). When the federal government eliminated CETA, Farmington Hills eliminated the cadet program in 1974, Dwyer sald.


