

World carillonneurs meet in Bloomfield Hills

Bells will be ringing even more than usual this summer when more than 250 carillonneurs from 10 European and North American countries meet in Ann Arbor and Bloomfield Hills Saturday through Tuesday, July 5-7.

The University of Michigan, with help from Christ Church Cranbrook and Kirk in the Hills, will host the World Carillon Federation's Seventh International Congress, the first congress ever convened outside Europe.

Free public recitals will be performed by WCF carillonneurs on the 5½-bell Charles Baird Carillon at U-

M each day except July 6, when Bloomfield Hills performances will be at 4 p.m. on the 50-bell Christ Church Cranbrook carillon, and at 8:30 p.m. at Kirk in the Hills, where the 77-bell carillon is the world's largest by number of bells.

Additional recitals at Christ Church by WCF attendees will be at 4 p.m. Sunday, June 29, and Sunday, July 13.

Also the world's largest traveling carillon will be demonstrated at 2 p.m. Sunday, July 6, at Cranbrook and at noon Monday, July 7, in Ann Arbor.

which is celebrating the 50th anniversary of the Burton Memorial Tower and its carillon — include a tribute to the late Percival Price, U-M carillonneur, 1939-1970; the world premier of Roy Hamlin Johnson's "The Liturgical Year: Easter" and other new works; presentation of a 15-year research project, "Bells and

Chiming in Spain"; representatives of bellfounders displaying their latest projects; presentations from each Guild with simultaneous translations in Dutch, English and French; and an experimental Dutch Carillon.

Also participating will be U-M carillonneur, William De Turk, Christ Church Cranbrook carillon-

neur, Beverly Buchanan, and Kirk in the Hills carillonneur, Frederick Marriott.

By definition, a carillon is an instrument of at least 23 cup-shaped bronze bells played by hand from a key board of wooden levers and pedals for control through touch. Instruments with fewer or mechanized bells are called chimes, peals or glockenspiels.

The World Carillon Federation comprises eight guilds from Great

Britain, the Netherlands, Belgium, France, West Germany, Denmark, Australia and North America (Canada, Mexico, United States). The Federation, founded in France in 1974, has 1,500 members. President is Miford Myrd carillonneur of the Bok Singing Tower, Lake Wales, Fla.

Pressler gives free concert

Menachem Pressler, pianist, will be guest soloist at the Clara and Peter Weisberg Concert at 8 p.m. Tuesday, at Congregation Shaarey Zedek, 27375 Bell, Southfield.

Performing with him will be Lucy Robert, violinist and faculty member at the University of Indiana.

The concert is open to the public and free, except for seats in the small patron section. For tickets, send a self-addressed envelope to the synagogue, ZIP code 48034. There will be more than 3,300 free seats. Reserved seating and an afterglow with the artists and media people is \$25.

Although Pressler was born in Germany, he received most of his musical training in Israel. He is a chamber musician as well as soloist and teacher. In 1955, he co-founded the Beaux Arts Trio, a chamber ensemble celebrating its 30th anniversary.

With the Trio and guest artists, Pressler has recorded almost all of today's chamber music with piano literature. Among the awards for these recordings is the Grand Prix du Disque in 1955.

Pressler, who appeared at Orchestra Hall twice this spring, has been professor of music at UI since 1956.
