

Oakland Traffic Deaths Decline

A decrease in traffic fatalities in Oakland County during the month of August has been reported by the Traffic Improvement Association of Oakland County (TIA).

Ten deaths were recorded in August, as compared to 14 in the same month last year, TIA announced.

The August figure brought the total traffic fatalities in the county to 96 for the first eight months of 1968, as compared to 95 for the same period in 1967.

While traffic deaths in Oakland County were holding even with last year, an increase of approximately 14 per cent was reported in the state and an increase of approximately five per cent in the nation.

CURRENTLY the local barracks of the Veterans of World War I has 39 members from Farmington, according to Ernest Leary, post commander.

Barracks No. 1152 has 66 veterans from Farmington, Southfield and Livonia and now the largest membership in its 11-year history.

Mr. Leary, who served in the Argonne Offensive, died Sept. 14 at his home at 32200 Freedom Dr. It was his 80th birthday.

Mr. Leary was assigned to Headquarters Company of the 313th Infantry from May 17, 1918 to June 9, 1919.

Mr. Leary was a charter member of Post No. 2 of the American Legion of New Jersey for 40 years and was a retired postal clerk from Baltimore, Md.

A full military funeral was held before Lyder presented the flag to Mr. Leary's wife, Laura.

MRS. O'CONNOR died Sept. 15 in Beverly Hills following a short illness.

Mrs. O'Connor, a 33-year resident of Farmington, served as a Navy nurse in World

War I. She lived at 31625 Grand River Ave.

Mrs. O'Connor, a registered nurse, served in the American Red Cross until 1966 and was active in the Daughters of Isabella, the League of Catholic Women and the Farmington Senior Citizens Club.

Burial for both World War I veterans was in North Farmington Cemetery.
