

### Oakland Traffic Deaths Decline

A decrease in traffic fatalities in the county to 96 for the first eight months of 1968, as compared to 95 for the same period in 1967.

While traffic deaths in Oakland County were holding even with last year, an increase of approximately 14 per cent was reported in the state and an increase of approximately five per cent in the nation.


Ten deaths were recorded in August, as compared to 14 in the same month last year, TIA announced.
