Listed are some of the Farmington-area police and fire calls received during the past week:

• SUSPECTS NABBED

Two teenagers face felony charges in connection with the alleged burglary of a Farmington Hills business Saturday morning.

Arraigned before District Judge Michael Hand of Farmington, the two — a 19-year-old from Southfield and an 18-year-old from Farmington Hills — pleaded not guilty to single counts of breaking and entering of a business with intent to commit lar-

cony. Conviction could bring a maximum penalty of up to 10 years in prison.

Hand set bond at \$2,500 for each pending a preliminary examination in 47th District Court.

The two were arrested after officers Daniel Luoma and Jon Grump responded to an alarm at Kemron Environmental Services, 32740 Northwestern, about 3:30 a.m. Saturday. The officers saw one of the teens running from the building and another exiting the building. The rear door was found pried open, according to the police report.

• FIRE REPORTED

A house under construction on Huntsman Drive in Rolling Oaks West subdivision sustained about \$250 in damage, the result of a suspicious fire, Tuesday, according to a Farmington Hills police report.

Burn marks were found on drywall in the hall and front room. A small piece of burned cardboard was found on the floor. A door frame was found partially burned. A metal gas can was found near the front porch. A five-gallon pail with burn marks was found in the back yard, according to the police report.

• 4 CHARGED

Four teenagers — a 17-year-old and an 18-year-old from Plymouth, a 17-year-old from Canton and a 17-year-old from Westland — face felony charges in connection with the alleged theft of a radar detector and a pair of binoculars from an unmarked police car in Farmington Hills early Tuesday.

Arraigned Tuesday before District Judge Margaret Schaeffer of Farmington, the four stood mute to one count of breaking and entering of a motor vehicle, punishable upon con-

viction by up to five years in prison and a \$1,000 fine, and one count of receiving and concealing stolen property over \$100, punishable upon conviction by up to five years in prison and a \$2,500 fine. All were released on personal bond pending a preliminary exam in 47th District Court.

The four were arrested after officers from the Farmington Hills Police Department's Special Patrol Operations Team saw them allegedly break into an unmarked police car parked in the Williamsburg Town-

houses about 2:30 a.m.

• CARS RECOVERED

A 1986 AMC Jeep Cherokee, valued at \$18,000 and reported stolen in Southfield, was recovered at Greenhill Apartments June 7, according to a Farmington Hills police report. The steering column was reported damaged.

A Pontiac Trans Am valued at \$12,000 was reported stolen from RV Electric, 27225 Eight Mile, on June 5, according to a Farmington Department of Public Safety report. It was later recovered in Detroit.

Rent car seats for kids

Public Act No. 117 requires all children under the age of 4 to be secured in an approved restraint device.
