- Consideration of determination for road improvement on Drake, between 13 and 14 Mile.
- Introduction of zoning amendment on the north side of 10 Mile, east of Orchard Lake, from RA-1 to SP-3. Proponent is Samir Mashni of the American Ramallah Federation.
- Introduction of zoning amendment at 32455 Northwestern Highway, east side of Clairview, from RA-4 to B-3. Proponent is Leonard Sigal of Triatira Co.
- Introduction of zoning amendment on northeast corner of 8 Mile and Middlebelt, from B-1 to B-3. Proponent is Bill Hartsock.
- Introduction of zoning amendment at 33966 Eight Mile, between Farmington and Cass, from RA-3 to OS-2. Proponent is Steve Orszag.
- Introduction of zoning amendment on east side of Haggerty, between Nine and 10 Mile, from RA-2 to OS-4. Proponent is Preston Shea.
- Consideration of vacation of utility easement in Oaklands subdivision in Westfield Road, extending approximately 250 feet north of Bond Blvd.

In other business, council will con-

sider appointments to the Farmington Hills Bloomfield Township joint road study committee. Also expected is the enactment of an ordinance prohibiting building or construction on Sundays and legal holidays.

Council is expected to award a bid for paving of Farmington Area Advisory Council parking lot, construction bids for 13 Mile paving between Drake and Halsted, as well as construction bids for water improvement on Richmond Hill and Northbrook in Westgate Franklin Village subdivision. Council also will consider approval of resolution to approve consolidated tax anticipation notes.

search, the selection of equipment to furnish the new Eagle Elementary media center, and a revision to the 1985-86 budget and transfer of the debt fund.
