Add Oriental twist to mums

Now is a good time to introduce new ideas to our established gardens. Michiganders are familiar with the sarvis cherry tree, which grows comfortably here. It is also known as shadoush, shadolow, shadoberry, June berry, June cherry and sarvis berry. The botanical same is Arris berry. The botanical same is Arris berry. The botanical same is Arris berry in the same is tree can attain a height of 20-plus feet, has many trunks and can grow into a beautiful symmetrical, unbrella-like structure. The bark is tight with small ridges. The owner is rewarded with a delicious fruit purplish-red in color about the size of a pea. A cycle of lovely white blossoms introduces the spring season. The sarvis berry will attract a variety of birds such as cedar wanted and so the same season will be a challenge to count the number of birds visiting your garden if you choose this tree.

MANY READERS feel that the garden season isn't complete unless they have a few chrysanthemum plants to assure early fall color. Those who wish to try a new idea

may want to guide a mum plant in its growth on a wire, resulting in a very artistic effect. Oriental gardeners have been practicing this skill for centuries.

Maybe you already have beautiful specimens. It is so easy to divide them. If not, buy a mum plant and place five cuttings in a skt-inch pot, allowing a margin above the soil line of about three-quarters of ma inch place to the continuence of the pot, only allowing them to extend on one side, sort of close together. For the continuers of the pot, only allowing them to extend on one side, sort of close together. Bend them at the top of the containers on they extend at a possible 45-degree angle. The wire should be a little finer than coat hanger wire and could be 24-in-ches long. Attach the growth ends to the wire.

Your mum plant grown in the Oriental manner will want only a small portion of the day in the shade, if at all. Finch out the top every tray when it will be ready to set buds for an early fall flowering. Don't forget to feed.



IF YOU ARE FOLLOWING a garden program this summer, you realize that gardening is filled with new adventures. For instance did you ever think of growing perhaps, three tomato plants in a bushel baset? Plant them equal distances apart about five inches from the edge of the basket. You can prepare to grow them on a wire cage at least three feet high, set close to the rim of the basket.

As the branches begin to grow and show evidence of budding toward fu-ture tomatoes, encourage the toma-toes to grow inside of the wire cage to keep their growth creet.

As an additional dividend in the narrow space around the perimeter outside the wire, you might like to plant marigolds and basil. We have now given you a conversation piece to place near your patio.
